PROGRAM CONTENT

This assembly is designed to acquaint students with one of the most influential persons of our country's history. By his strong convictions to advocate for the civil rights for all people (regardless of color), Dr. King has in some way touched the lives of everyone.

The assembly begins with a dramatization of Rosa Parks and then is followed by a historically focused poem about Martin Luther King, Jr. The program continues with an innovative activity that provides the students with a personal experience with color discrimination. The assembly's closure is upbeat and motivational with the inclusion of a participatory song that offers a way to bring peace to the world and celebrate our differences.

The program lasts for approximately 45 minutes and is limited to 400 students. For schools with larger populations, it will be necessary to schedule more than one assembly. (a 10% discount is given for 2 or more assemblies)
